

Open the **Terminal** application on your Mac. To open Terminal, you can use one of the following:

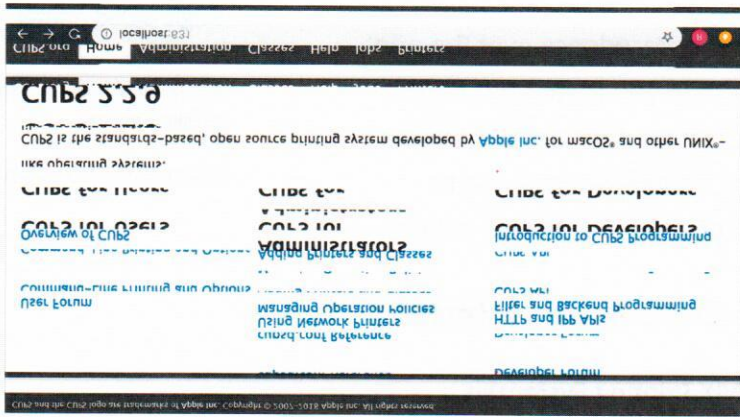
- Click the Spotlight icon in the top-right corner of the screen.
- Use Spotlight to search for Terminal.
- Click the Terminal icon in the Dock.
- Click the Terminal icon in the Applications folder.

At the prompt, type `sudo cp /usr/bin/curl /usr/bin/curl.bak` and press **Return**.

Enter your Mac computer password when prompted and press **Return**.

Once Terminal prompts you for your password, type `sudo cp /usr/bin/curl /usr/bin/curl.bak` and press **Return**.

Open Safari or any other browser and visit <http://apple.com>. You should see the Apple logo. If you see a message that says "Apple.com is not available", you may need to restart your computer.



Go to the **Printers** tab and select your printer from the list.
