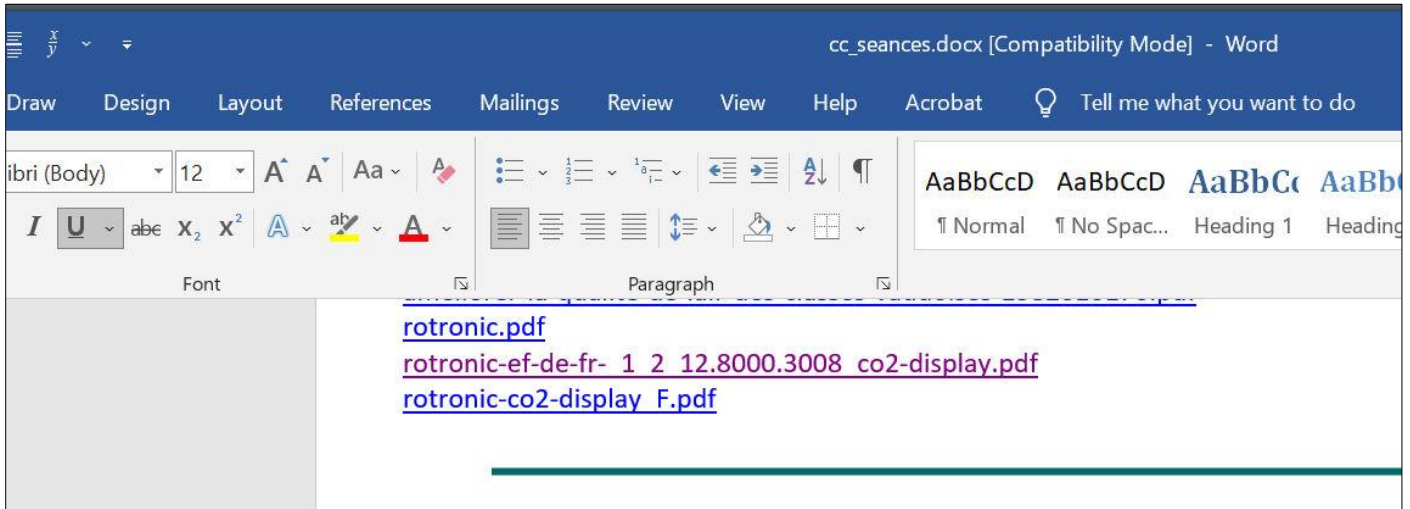


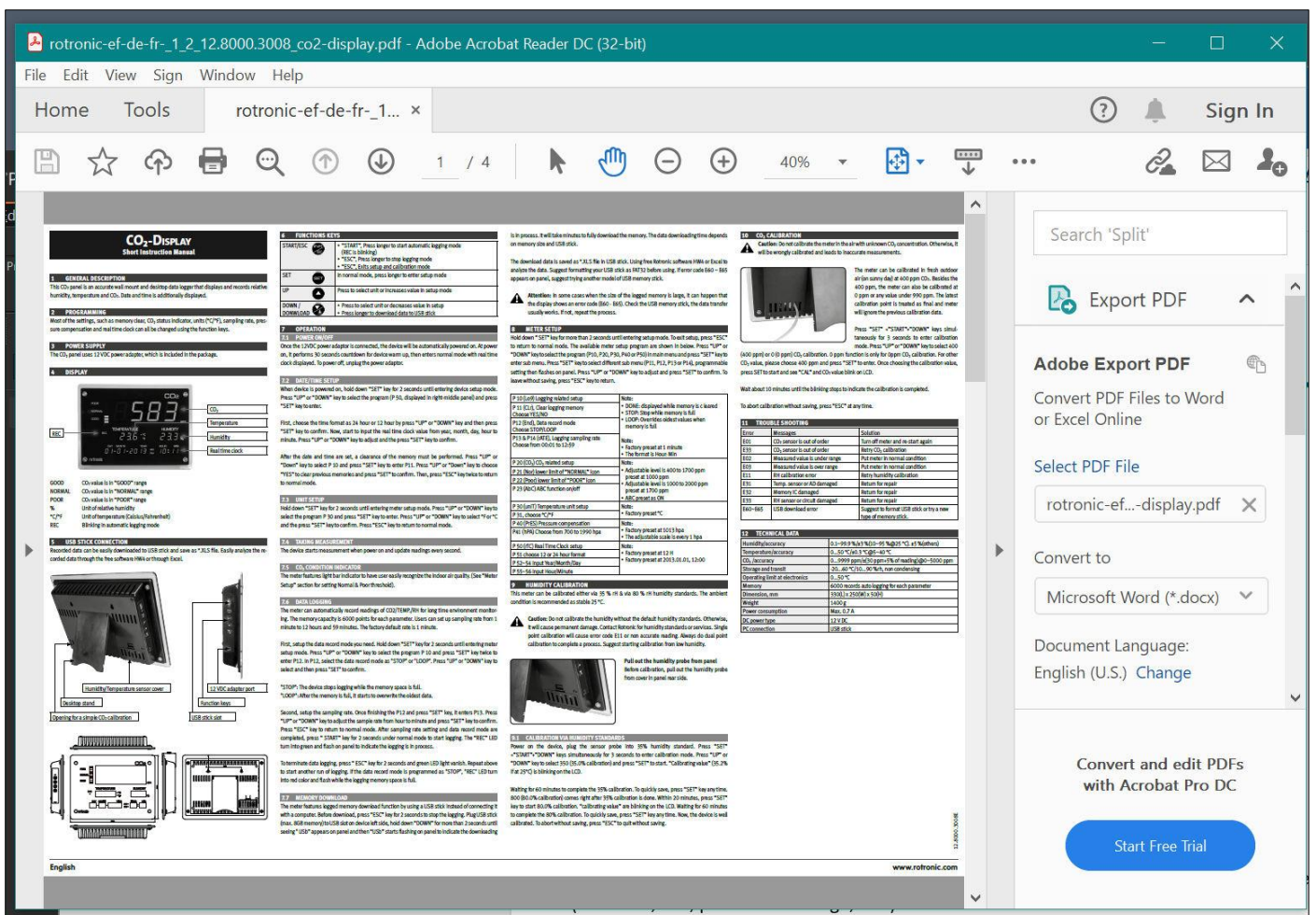
Word opens hyperlinks with Acrobat DC trial or Reader instead of Acrobat Pro

In a Word document, when I click on hyperlink pointing to pdf...



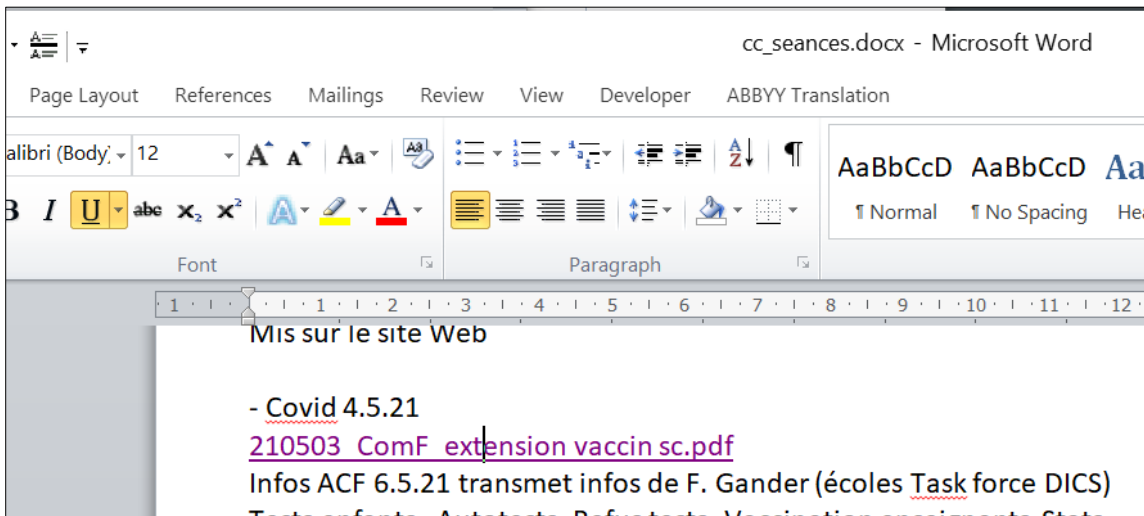
It opens with Adobe Acrobat DC trial (light, unwanted, unpaid) and not with AcrobatPro 2020 (full, paid)



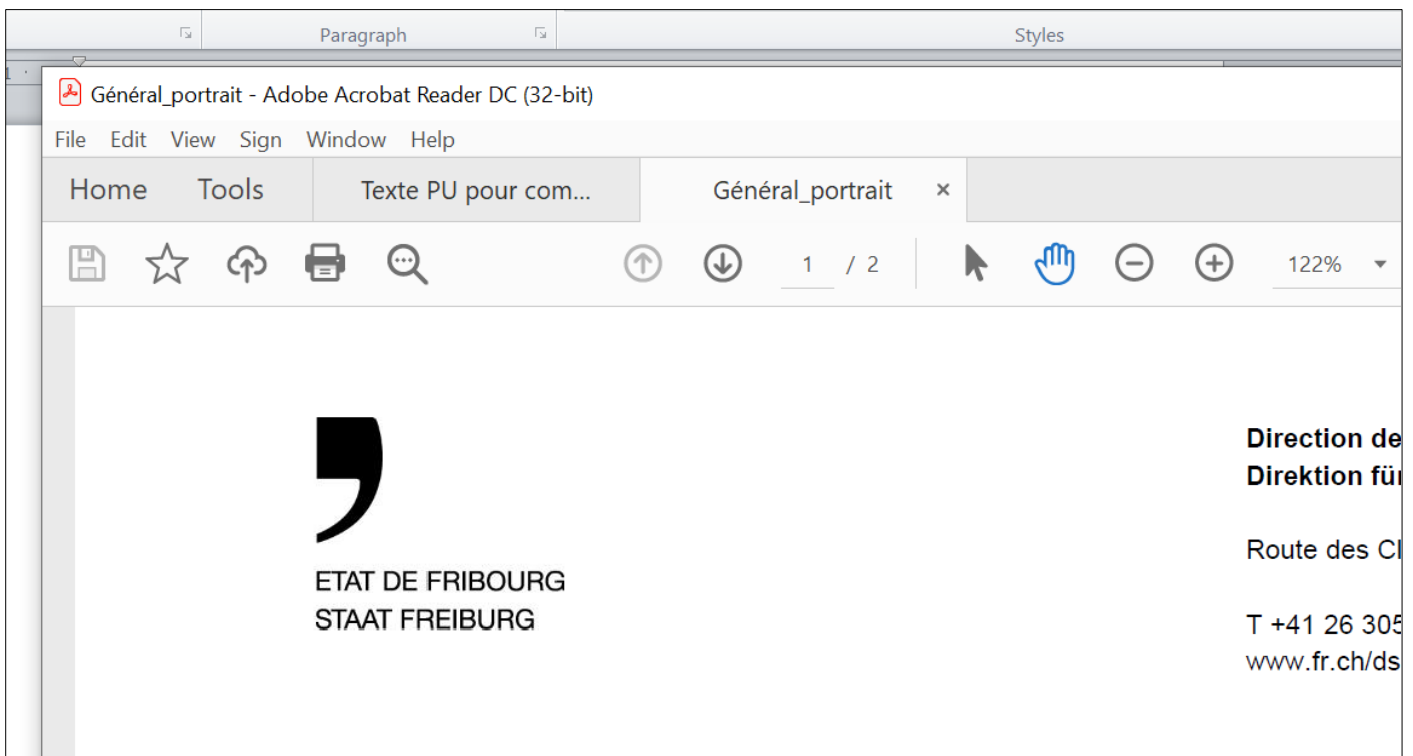
Computer 2: Windows 10 Pro, Word 2010, Acrobat XI Pro

In a Word document, when I click on hyperlink pointing to pdf...

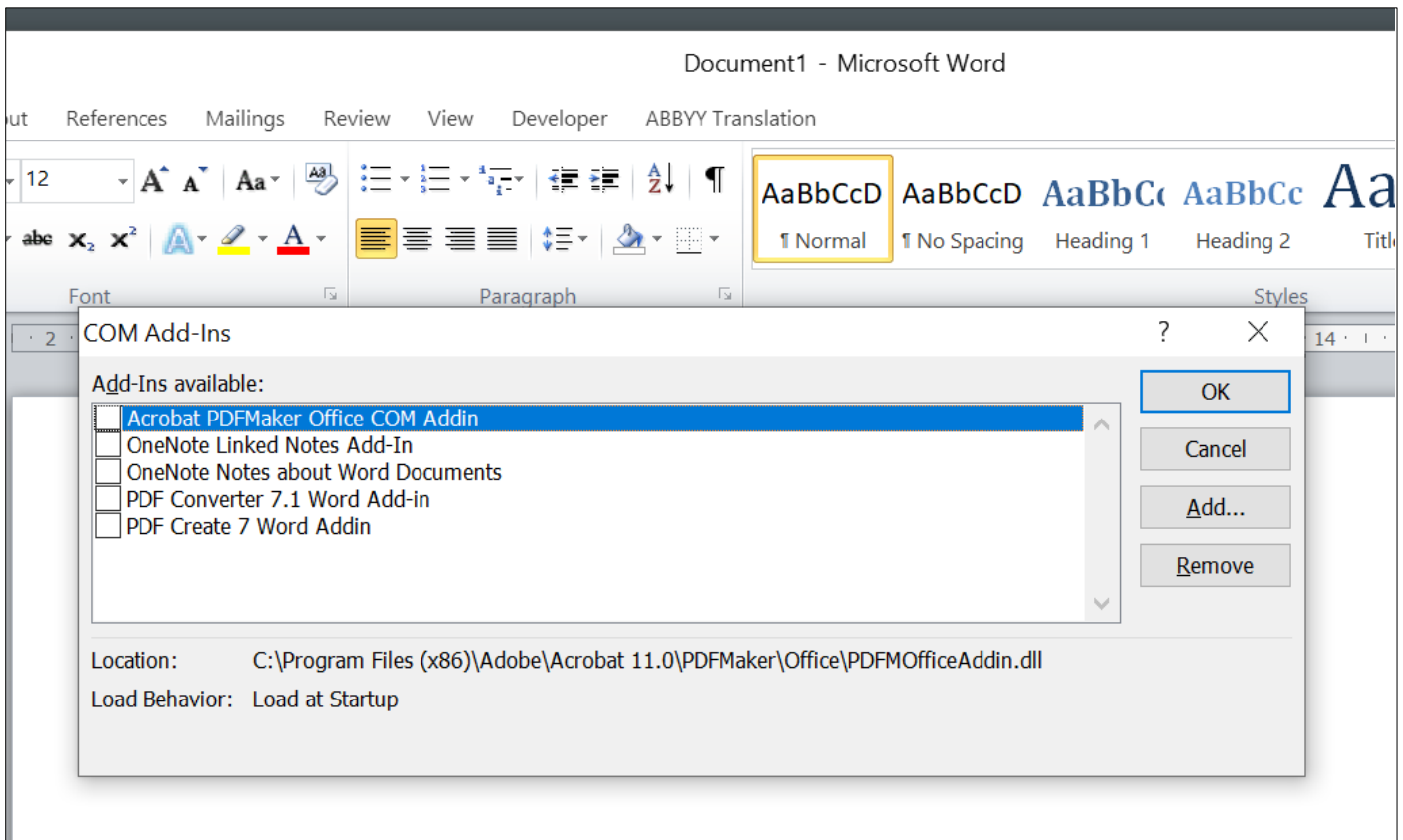


it opens Adobe Acrobat DC trial (light, unwanted, unpaid) and not my Acrobat Pro XI (full, paid, excellent):



In Word **Options**: Impossible to create an add-in pointing to Acrobat Pro.

Checked or unchecked it is the same. Links are opened with DC trial:



In all Windows 10 computers **Default applications** are correctly set.

It works with Windows explorer, Firefox, LibreOffice, etc. Not with MS Word, Excel, etc.:
