SHINE IN YOUR BEST!



At least one of your outfits should be dressy. Pick something special to commemorate this once-in-a-lifetime event! You want to look your very best! Long flowing dresses and sharp, tucked-in shirts and suits lend themselves to an elegant, classic look! High-heels will make your outfit and elongate your legs! Your location and wardrobe should go well with one another. This will allow your images to flow and feel more like a cohesive piece of art.



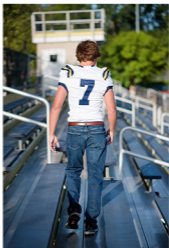


INCORPORATE HOBBIES AND PASSIONS

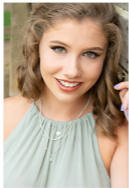

HAIR AND MAKEUP



I highly recommend all of my senior girls invest in professional hair and makeup if it fits within your budget. Hiring a professional stylist will make a tremendous difference in the quality of your photos. Plus, letting yourself be "pampered" will make your senior picture experience a lot more fun and remove the stress of trying to do it yourself!

If you decide to do your own makeup, I encourage going a little heavier than normal. The camera tends to "soften" the face, so going bolder will help your look stand out! This is especially important for lipstick! Go bright on the lips!

DON'T FORGET THE NAILS!

Your nails will show in some of the close-up pictures, so be sure they look their best!

FOR THE FELLAS...



> Unless you have facial hair, come to your session smooth, shaving just a few hours before your session.

> If you get a haircut for your session, be sure to do it at least 2 weeks ahead of time.

> Stay away from busy patterns, especially tiny pinstripes as they can cause the photos to look fuzzy.

> Pay attention to your shoes! Make sure your shoes look great as they will show in full-length shots.

> Feel free to accessorize with hats, sunglasses, jackets, or boots

> Make sure your clothes fit you well and are not too baggy.

> Don't forget the belt if your outfit calls for one!
